





Gaddam D. Reddy, MD



Dr. Reddy was born in India in a small village Mahammadapuram, Andhra Pradesh. After his initial education, he completed his MBBS from Osmania Medical College in 1959. He then pursued his post-graduation in Pediatrics from Bombay. Later served as Professor of Pediatrics at the Niloufer Hospital in Hyderabad till 1968, during which time he established a 20 bedded hospital in his village to serve the needy. In 1968 Dr. Reddy arrived in the United States on a Fulbright scholarship at the world-renowned Boston children's hospital and medical center, and later completed his fellowship in Pediatric Cardiology at Long Island Jewish Medical Center, NY. He then returned to In-

dia in 1973 as a professor of Pediatric Cardiology to impart his knowledge and offer his services at the Osmania Medical College and Niloufer Hospital. Dr. Reddy subsequently returned to the United States in 1976 to enhance his own children's education and further his knowledge in pediatric cardiology. He has since been Director, Vice Chairman and Chairman at various esteemed institutions of NY in the last four decades. He is a published author and clinical researcher.

Dr. Reddy has been to many countries and led various medical missions to India, Guatemala and Haiti. He is a "gem of exceptional glitter" of the Indian society in New York for the past five decades. He acted as leader of the community and fostered Indian culture to a generation of Indians in the US, presided over several National Indian organizations. He instilled the value of service to God and peace to the soul to millions of Indians. He is instrumental in the establishment of Basavatarakam Indo-American Cancer Center in Hyderabad, India which serves millions of Cancer patients on charity.

He is still active as Chairman, Board of Trustees of the Hindu Temple Society of NA in Flushing, NY. He is an ardent and generous giver to the society both in US and India. Dr. Reddy remains down to earth and has an unassuming personality which is contagious. Dr. Gaddam has been blessed with a dedicated wife Smt. Jyotsna and 3 beautiful children, six grandchildren and even better a great grandchild. He enjoys music, traditional Indian literature, history and most of all the company of his friends. He finds that there is nothing more wonderful in life than to have good friends, a loving family and ability to teach and to continuously learn. He believes learning is a lifelong business opportunity.

Satish Anand, MD

Here is a man, who has proved himself despite all odds in his life. Dr. Anand's family moved to India in 1948. His father, Manohar Lal Anand, and the rest of the family got separated during the partition and were lucky to reunite after some time. Dr. Anand was three years old when he suffered from Polio in the

left lower extremity. That was in 1945.



In 1948 when the family started their journey to India, his mother had him in his arms. The family was traveling in a truck which got stuck in the River, Ravi. A Pakistani soldier suggested to his mother that she could throw him away instead of carrying him with so much difficulty. Also, it will reduce weight in the truck which could then come unstuck. And, on top of it, she had 3 more children; so, she should have had no hesitation in getting rid of a disabled boy of 5 years. His Mother Krishna Kumari Anand, said, "I will die with him if my "OM" wishes. But one day you'll see he will become a big person." She could easily have got rid of her disabled son, but she was not an ordinary woman. She was courageous, brave and had immense heroic-qualities which Dr. Anand has inherited from her.

Another great gift to him from his mother is the unflinching faith in "OM." She instilled in him power of Faith. She told Satish, "Have Faith in your OM and do your karma (work/duty). Everything else will follow." It is this valuable lesson of life which has helped Dr. Anand.

Thereafter, he read a few books by great minds, including Swami Vivekananda. He recalls how profoundly he was influenced by Swami Vivekananda's words: "To do your duty with honesty, sincerity, and faith in Almighty is the biggest worship of God." He has always kept these golden words in his mind.

The values cherished today have come to Dr. Anand from his mother. Dr. Anand was born in Rawalpindi (now Pakistan) on October 21, 1942 to Manohar Lal Anand and Krishna Kumari Anand. He studied at Mhow, near Indore in Madhya Pradesh, India. He received his Medical education at Medical College, Gwalior to become a physician in 1965. In 1968, he went to the UK to do his residency program and finally got his MRCP in 1973. He came to the US in 1975 and worked as full time internist. He retired in 2009.

Dr. Satish Anand himself has been socially and professionally involved. He has been a member of

AAPI – QLI since 1995. He was its President and now sits on Board of Trustees. He was President of Federation of AAPI NY/NJ/CT. He is a member of Rajasthan Medical Alumni Association. Earlier, he was president of Gajra Raja Medical College Association. Dr. Anand's contribution has been hailed by various organizations and institutions. In 2013, Rotary International honored him with The Humanitarian Award.

Married to Gitanjli Anand, the couple has two daughters, Aikta (married to Mukesh Sethi) and Vaishali (married to Amit Deshmukh) and are blessed with five grandchildren; Mukta & Aksha Sethi and Manav, Meera, & Milan Deshmukh.

Manjeet Chadha, MD, MHA, FASTRO, FACR

Dr. Chadha is Professor of Radiation Oncology at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, and the Director of the department at Mount Sinai Downtown. Prior to this appointment she served as Associate Chair of the department of Radiation Oncology Beth Israel Medical Center, and was the



Director for Breast and Gynecologic Cancer Programs for Radiation Oncology at Continuum Cancer Centers of New York. Dr. Chadha is a Fellow of the American College of Radiology, and Fellow of the American Society of Radiation Oncology, an honor bestowed on highly select Radiation Oncologists' in America.

Dr. Chadha received her medical education in India. Graduating at the top of her class from Amritsar Medical College, she completed her post-graduate training in Radiation Oncology at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York. She also has a Master's degree in Healthcare Administration from the Mailman School of Public Health, Columbia University.

Dr. Chadha's clinical and research interests primarily focus on improving treatment and clinical outcomes in breast and gynecologic cancers while

aiming to preserve quality of life of cancer survivors. She has authored over 170 peer-reviewed articles, abstracts, book chapters and invited articles.

As a mentor, Dr. Chadha has an extensive educator's portfolio of trainees/residents, fellows, and medical students. Her research/publications endorse her collaborative and mentoring skills. Widely respected in her field, she is a frequent speaker at national/ international academic venues.

Throughout her career, Dr. Chadha has championed quality in cancer care delivery and has introduced several quality improvement initiatives to impact change. She currently serves as co-chair of Mount Sinai Cancer Multidisciplinary System-wide Quality Improvement Committee.

Dr. Chadha has served as President of the New York Metropolitan Breast Cancer Group, and President of the New York Roentgen Society. She is a member of the Medical Advisory Committee of the Komen Foundation, and has served on Manhattan's Regional Board of Advisors of the American Cancer Society. She is in the Castle Connolly's list of America's Top Doctors, and since 2006 has also been on the roster of Best Doctors, and Top Oncologist in America.

In summary, Dr. Chadha is a recognized leader in the field of medicine with contributions to patient care in oncology, clinical research, and medical education. She acknowledges her responsibility as a treating physician with deep gratitude and humility, and is inspired by her patients and thousands of courageous women facing the diagnosis of cancer. On a personal note, she feels extremely blessed and most grateful to be surrounded and supported by her wonderful loving family, great friends and colleagues.



Alan D. Guerci, M.D.

Alan D. Guerci, M.D. is president and chief executive officer of Catholic Health Services of Long Island, an appointment that was effective on July 1, 2013. Previously, he was

executive vice president for CHS and President & CEO of St. Francis Hospital, Mercy Medical Center and St. Joseph Hospital.

Before assuming executive leadership for St. Francis Hospital in 1999 (and Mercy and St. Joseph more recently), Alan was St. Francis's executive vice president for medical affairs and director of research. Previously, he served as director of the Coronary Care Unit at The Johns Hopkins Hospital, as well as chairman of the Clinical Trials Review Committee of the Heart, Lung and Blood Institute of the National Institutes of Health.

After graduating from Harvard College, Alan earned his medical degree from Cornell University Medical College and a master's degree in health care management from the Harvard School of Public Health. He completed postgraduate training as an intern, resident and chief resident at the University of California, San Francisco Medical Center, followed by a fellowship in cardiology at The Johns Hopkins Hospital, where he advanced to the rank of associate professor of medicine before joining St. Francis. In addition, he is an associate professor of clinical medicine at the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Columbia University.





Jason Naidich, MD

Jason Naidich, M.D. is senior vice president and executive director of Northwell Health's

Central Region, which includes North Shore University Hospital (NSUH), Long Island Jewish (LIJ) Medical Center, Cohen Children's Medical Center, LIJ Forest Hills, LIJ Valley Stream and Zucker Hillside Hospital. In this role, Dr. Naidich develops and oversees implementation of strategic plans to achieve patient satisfaction, quality, operational and financial goals for the region's hospitals. He is also responsible for coordinating activity within the region, building physician partnerships and identifying new opportunities for growth and investment.

In 2001, Dr. Naidich started his career as an attending interventional radiologist at North Shore University Hospital. In additional to his clinical work, Dr. Naidich assumed a series of leadership positions within the radiology department, ultimately serving as Northwell's system-wide Chair of Radiology and Senior Vice President of the Imaging Service Line, a position he held until the end of 2016.

In 2013, Dr. Naidich became the Chair of Radiology at the Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/Northwell, a position he continues to hold today. In this capacity, he oversees undergraduate and graduate medical education as well as the research activities of the department which has over 150 faculty members.

Dr. Naidich is a member of numerous professional organizations and has recently served as President of the New York State Radiological Society. He has been elected as a Fellow of the American College of Radiology. He serves on several education, economics and finance committees for the American College of Radiology and the Association of University Radiologists and is a reviewer for several radiology journals.

Dr. Naidich earned his medical degree from Cornell University Medical College. He completed an internship in Internal Medicine at Lenox Hill Hospital and a residency in diagnostic radiology at New York University Medical Center, where he also served as Chief Resident. Dr. Naidich completed a fellowship in vascular and interventional radiology at New York University Medical Center and a second fellowship in magnetic resonance imaging at Beth Israel-Deaconess Medical Center, Boston. He later earned an MBA with a concentration in health care management from Yale University.
