





65 years ago, I left the town for college education. And what I learnt from my parents is education and imagination. I was raised in joint family with multiple siblings. There was palpable class and gender discrimination in the town.

My father's imaginary thoughts started when he established the first library in the town as resource for learning. Then opened girl's college after raising his voice against gender discrimination when he was chairperson of Sirsa Education Society. Currently it provides graduate and post graduate facilities along with dorms for the girl's students from the nearby villages

He used to tell me imagine what goes through in the mind of people who don't have facilities, cannot afford education and to deal with class discrimi-

nation. As chairman of Sirsa Development and housing society he managed to get approval to build J. J Colony which was allotted to under privileged people who did not have place to live.

His Philanthropic belief made him to donate his entire share of more than three hundred acres land. The land was distributed by Shri Vinoba Bhave and Shri Jaya Prakash Narayan.

My brother got his eye traumatized with opening of Coca-Cola bottle and he has to travel multiple times to Delhi for treatment for corneal injury and loss of sight. Imagine how people will get the treatment without the availability of medical facility. Charitable Eye care hospital was opened for the care of everybody. After the death of my mother she donated her cornea in the same hospital to the boy who lost his eye sight as complication of small pox. Imagine what he will be imagining today.

After his death, people of town are remembering and paying homage to the statue in his honor which he would not have imagined and approved. Charitable outpatient clinic is functioning as well at the site of his statue.

After I retired from my practice I enjoy interacting with senior citizens at nursing homes, senior citizen enter to assist with their HMO health issues, drug plans affordability, and interacting with their physicians as Patient advocate.

I was told to imagine and now the grand children are teaching to innovate as well.,

We are proud and thankful to this country for the best opportunity offered.

It is an incredible honor to accept the award from AAPIQLI family and sincerely thank each one of you. It means more to me than you will ever know. We are indebted and thankful for the prayers and wishes which were successful in speedy recovery from the serious medical condition in family.



Dr. Nageswara (Neil) Mandava was born in India and is a medical graduate of Rangaraya Medical College, Andhra Pradesh, India. He completed General Surgery Residency at Catholic Medical



Centers of Brooklyn & Queens in 1986. He then went on to pursuit a Surgical Oncology Fellowship at Roswell Park Cancer Institute, Buffalo, NY from 1986-1989. There he received the American Cancer Society Research award for the two years, 1988 and 1989. He has numerous publications in peer review Journals and has academic rank of Professor of Surgery. He has academic appointments with New York Medical College, NYIT, St. George's University and American University of Caribbean

Dr. Dilip Patel was born in Nairobi, Kenya in 1954. He received his primary and part of his high school education in Kampala, Uganda. Due to the unrest and social injustices towards the Asians in Uganda, he was sent to India at the age of 16 while his parents eventually migrated to England. He graduated



from St. Xavier's High School in Ahmedabad in 1971. He ranked amonast the top 10 in the Senior Secondary School Examination Board in The State of Gujarat and received National Merit Scholarship. Entered Medical School, attaining 4th rank amongst 1,500 applicants for Medical Entrance Examination 1973.

He graduated from Medical College Baroda achieving third rank in his graduating class and was a registrar in Internal Medicine at SSG Hospital in Baroda, prior to moving to USA. He completed his Internal Medicine residency at Lincoln Hospital in Bronx, New York. He completed his Fellowship training in Hematology Oncology at University of Connecticut in Farmington.

In 1988, he joined as an attending physician at Long Island Jewish Medical Center in New Hyde Park, New York under the leadership of Dr. Kanti Rai. During his 25 years of career at the institution he had many different re-

sponsibilities. He was the Fellowship Program Director in the division of Hematology Oncology at Long Island Jewish Medical Center and has mentored more than 50 fellows in 18 years. He was the Chief of Hematology in the Department of Pathology which included overseeing the operation of Clinical Hematology Laboratory. He was the Medical Director for Long Island Jewish Medical Center Homecare for 22 years. Dr. Patel was Associate Prof. of Medicine at Albert Einstein Medical School and Hofstra Medical School in 2013 prior to his departure to St. Francis Hospital.

Currently, Dr. Patel is Vice Chair of Hematology and Malignant Hematology Services at St. Francis Hospital in Roslyn, New York. He is a member of several academic societies including the American Society of Hematology (ASH) and American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO). He has authored several abstracts, papers and book chapters which have been presented at major conferences nationally and internationally. His primary interest is Hematological Malignancies, Benign Hematology and in particular coagulation disorders and to this end has remained an active investigator for institutional and multi-center clinical trials for over 30 years. Currently he heads Clinical Research in Division of Hematology Oncology at St. Francis Hospital under the auspices of Catholic Health Systems of Long Island.

He credits his current achievement to his patients, who have taught him tremendously and inspired him to be a better human being. He is indebted to Dr. Kanti Rai for his mentorship and constant guidance. He is greatly thankful to Dr. Bhoomi Mehrotra who continues to work tirelessly and has in a very short time put together a highly reputable Oncology Program with the unrelenting support of the Catholic Health Systems of Long Island (CHSLI) administration. Bhuvanesh Singh MD, PhD has been on the faculty at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center for over 20 years. He is a clinician and scientist that continually strives not only to perfect his clinical abilities but also to advance clinical and basic science research efforts for head and neck cancers. He has developed innovative approaches to surgery, instituted measures

that improve psychosocial outcomes, and developed novel anticancer agents that are currently

being optimized for use in clinical trials.



Dr. Singh has performed over 6000 major surgical procedures in his career. The insight gained from this experience allowed him to develop and optimize a novel fascial plane-based approach to performing head and neck surgery. This approach was developed in the cadaver laboratory and has become the cornerstone of how he performs a wide range of surgical procedures. The fundamental principles of the fascial plane-based surgical approach allows maintenance of optimal oncological outcomes while dramatically reducing recovery time and improving functional and cosmetic outcomes. What is especially important is that the technique is highly reproducible. This makes it easier for others to duplicate the observed results once they assimilate the basic surgical skills. Thus, training residents and fellows becomes easier as well as more efficient.

Dr Singh is a NIH funded researcher that is focused on developing a new compound of a novel oncogene that he discovered during his PhD training. Work from his laboratory formed the

basis of the drug-discovery project, having defined the biochemical, cellular, and oncological basis of the gene he discovered. This first-in-class lead compound is highly effective in the treatment of a broad range of cancers in mice. Dr. Singh's team is now working toward optimizing this compound, before taking the steps necessary to initiate clinical trials. He is hopeful that, in the next two years, he will complete the work required to initiate clinical trials. This has been a first of its kind bench-to-bedside process in that he identified the genetic abnormality in cancer cells, cloned the gene driving selection for the genetic abnormality, identified its biological and cancer-related functions, and developed agents that target its activity.

Dr. Singh has also been involved in the training of medical students, residents, and fellows. His trainees have gone on to lead surgical and research programs in the topmost institutions around the world. Dr. Singh's success reflects a novel educational approach he developed that combining the strengths of traditional and modern surgical education models. This combined model for surgical education, or CoMSE, applies structure to the opportunistic learning model by optimizing educational interactions, monitoring experiences, and providing critical and timely feedback to educators and trainees.


Dr. Singh has published over 200 peer reviewed research articles, 30 book chapters, and is the co-editor of the major textbook in head and neck surgery. He serves as the co-Director of the Advanced Skin Cancer Management and prevention Program and runs a research program that is at the verge of major discovery. He is a recognized leader in his field and a sought after speaker worldwide. Even with these achievements, he values nothing more than the opportunity to affect a person's life during what is often their darkest hour.

It is truly humbling for me to be selected as a honoree by the American Association of Physicians of Indian Origin of Queens and Long Island. I am honored to be included amongst a list of current and past honorees that represent true leaders in modern medicine not only in the Indian community but also worldwide. It is even more meaningful to be selected by the leadership and members of this society, people who I consider role models and heroes in our community. The innumerable sacrifices and contribution by the APPI-QLI membership are the building blocks for for my career and a major basis for my achievements. In accepting this award, I thank the members of AAPI-QLI for making it possible.

I would also like to acknowledge the support of my family and friends. Their support and motivation drive all of the work I do. If I have achieved, it is because of the sacrifices of my family. To this end, I would like to recognize my wife, an exceptional wife, mother and pediatrician, my parents and in laws, especially my mother whose unconditional love drives my aspirations, my brother an exceptional ophthalmologist and lifelong friend, and my three sons- Manish, Devan and Neel- who mean more to me than anything in the world.
