





Convention Startegic Chairman Message



I am honored and humbled to serve in the newly created role of Strategic chairman for Silver Jubilee Annual Gala Celebration and Convention. As the year started, COVID-19 Pandemic was still raging, upending the rhythms of daily life and fostering in uncertainty around the world. The worsening Pandemic created an atmosphere of anxiety and fear and any planning about Celebration was impossible to think about. With the worsening crisis, AAPI-QLI leadership's total attention, strategically, was devoted to helping Covid Victims, here in the USA and in our mother India.

As part of the Silver Jubilee Celebration, a collective drive was started by AAPI-QLI leadership in collaboration with area hospitals and other non-profit organizations. A significant amount of funds were raised.

These funds were used to send Oxygen Concentrators, Oximeters, Personal Protective Equipment's (PPE) to critically affected areas in India. Philanthropic financial assistance was provided to the victims' families and survivors in USA. PPE and Face Shields were donated to Nursing homes, hospitals and member physicians to assist them to be safe in operating their facilities. A fully equipped Ambulance was sent to a rural area in Haryana for transporting sick patients to the district hospital and finally an Oxygen Generating Plant was donated to a charitable institution with 40 beds devoted to COVID care. On behalf of AAPI-QLI and its Executive Committee and Board of Trustees I am grateful to every donor for their contribution. Your generosity saved lives.

Throughout the first phase of the pandemic, many of our member physicians and other essential health care workers got infected, suffered a great deal, fought like warriors on the front lines. Sadly, some succumbed to this terrible disease and lost their lives. We join their families, friends and colleagues in grief. In the wake of these tragedies, AAPI-QLI leadership, strategically decided to broaden our initiatives by adding "Donor Advised Memorial Funds with a Mission" - By-Laws were modified to include this new dimension. The addition was ratified by the Executive Committee, Board of Trustees and finally by the General Body Membership and I am very proud to report that our very first "Dr. Ajay Lodha Memorial Endowment Fund" is being inaugurated during this AAPI-QLI Silver Jubilee Celebration Gala as another milestone to help our community. This fund would provide financial assistance to the needy Indian medical students and award scholarships to encourage research activities.

I wish to express my gratitude to our President, Dr. Abhay Malhotra and his entire Executive Committee including all Board of Trustees & Advisors for entrusting me with this great responsibility. I also extend my best wishes for our incoming President, Dr. Vinni Jayam, he is organized, energized, innovative and possesses exceptional leadership qualities. Finally, my sincere appreciation to my wife, Meena for her support and encouragement.



Hospital of New York Medical College.


He joined the faculty of New York Medical College in 1975 as Clinical Instructor and rose through the years to the rank of Professor of Surgery. He joined the staff at Westchester Medical Center in 1980. Together with his colleague and partner Dr. Pravin Shah, established the Division of Vascular Surgery which is now a nine man team including the northern campuses of WMC Health. Under his leadership, Vascular Surgery at WMC earned a great reputation for delivering the state of art care to patients with vascular diseases. He was responsible with the leadership of hospital Administration

to create the Westchester Heart & Vascular Institute comprising of Cardiothoracic Surgery, Cardiology and Vascular Surgery working together as a team of experts to treat diseases of the heart and blood vessels. This model initiated here at WMC in 1998, is now seen in all major institutions all across the country.

Dr. Babu is well known academically, presenting at various local, regional, national and international meetings. He has authored and coauthored numerous publications. He was featured on the cover of the WESTCHESTER MAGAZINE's health issue (2008) as the "TOP DOCTOR". He has received many awards as the best teacher by residents. He recently stepped down from the position of Division Chief after forty years

Dr. Babu was Secretary, Vice President and President of KSMD (Karnataka State Medical and Dental) Alumni Association of America, one of the largest alumni group in USA. He has been the CME chair of that organization for the past thirty-five years. He and his wife are life members of AAPI. Dr. Babu and his wife Sudhamani, a pediatrician, live in Tarrytown, Westchester, New York. They have two daughters. He and his wife enjoy travelling, learning about the different peoples and cultures around the globe.


Dinker Belle Rai, MD

Vascular Surgeon, Interfaith Medical Center


Dr. Rai is a noted vascular surgeon who has served the Brooklyn community for 48 years. He is an inventor and pioneer in the field of venous surgery. He has dedicated years of research on the heart that resulted in a book currently under publication titled Mechanical function of Atrial Diastole: A New Discovery and Motion of blood in the Venous System - Novel Findings

Dr. Dinker Belle Rai is a Board Certified Indian American vascular surgeon who served as the Chairman of the Department of Surgery and as the Chief of the Department of Vascular Surgery / Vascular Laboratory at the Interfaith Medical Center, Brooklyn, New York. Dr. Rai is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons and a Fellow of the Royal Canadian College of Surgeons.



Dr. Rai was born in Puttur, Karnataka, India on 28 April 1947 to Kedambady Narayana Rai, a famous criminal lawyer practicing in Mangalore and Belle Sanjivi Rai. He currently lives in Old Westbury, Long Island, New York with his wife Shakila Rai. They have three children - Seema, Arjun and Rahul.

In terms of education and training, Dr. Rai received his medical degree (MBBS) from Bangalore Medical College where he graduated with a distinction in Pathology. Dr. Rai received his surgical training in the General Surgery Residency training program at the Brooklyn Jewish Hospital and Medical Center of New York from 1974 to 1977, Chief Residency in Surgery in 1977 to 1978 and Fellowship in Vascular Surgery specializing in venous diseases at Maimonides Medical Center, Brooklyn, New York in 1979.

During his formative years as a medical professional, Dr. Rai was among a select group of doctors that noted the arduous and abusive work conditions of medical residents and went on a first ever strike in 1974. This strike resulted in a change for the better in terms of lifestyle, working hours, training, and remuneration for the residents.

Dr. Rai was an accomplished sportsman and captained the Bangalore University cricket team that won the South Zone finals and that, for the first time, went all way to the All-India finals in 1969. He captained the Combined Universities Cricket team of the South Zone of India and Sri Lanka in 1969. He was selected for the Karnataka Ranji Trophy team in 1970. In lieu of his contribution to cricket, his name is on the Honor Roll at the Chinnaswamy Stadium Cricket Museum in Bangalore.

He developed the first ever method for retrograde catheterization of the venous tree. This invention was given a United States patent in 1988. Based on this patent, a company called The Ideas For Medicine, Inc. (now part of Horizon Medical Products, Inc.) manufactured and still distributes out a series of catheters, known as Rai's Catheters for use in performing descending phlebographic tests and for venous embolectomies.

In terms of medical discoveries, Dr. Rai discovered the motion of venous valves in human beings. This new information on venous valves comes almost 500 years after discovery by Fabricus Acquapedente of Padua University that venous valves are one-way doors allowing blood to go towards the heart. He discovered that venous blood flow is pulsatile which, prior to Rai's discovery, was described only as linear flow. His original research on histopathological specimens of patients with sapheno-femoral – incompetency resulted in a paradigm shift in management of varicose veins. He performed the first ever vein transplantation below the knee. His monumental work is the discovery of right atrial mechanical function is a pivotal discovery in his medical research field. The book on the mechanical function of the Heart is going to be released soon. He has authored two chapters in textbook of Angiology and wrote a beginner's manual on sclerotherapy and management of varicose veins and is a pioneer in the field of venous surgery with several publications and presentations.

He is an accomplished Artist. At age 14, a portrait he made of then US President John F. Kennedy, based on a photograph by Yousef Karsh, was presented President Kennedy. It was received by the president who reciprocated with letter of appreciation and is, at present, preserved and exhibited at JFK library in Boston.

Dr. Rai has also served on the Board and as the Chairman of the Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, United States. Under his leadership, the Bhavan conducted the first international conference on Ayurveda, Vedic Astrology, Bhagavad Gita and held the Hindi Sammelan at the UNO. He has contributed various articles to the Bhavans Journal such as A Travellers Experience, Goddess Kali, Mystery of Om, Gita - The Gospel of Krishna, Lingering Feelings, Conversations with Swami Bua, Masters of all Masters, salutations to Sage Kapila, Patanjali's Ashtanga Yoga, and several other articles on Vedanta.

In the same practice for over thirty years, Dr. Robinson has been integral to the growth and development of contemporary cardiac surgery at St. Francis Hospital, Roslyn, NY. An innovator an early adopter, he was directly and primarily responsible for the growth of the routine use of arterial conduits for treatment of coronary disease (Internal Mammary Artery CABG), devise therapy for treatment of sudden death, advanced operations for thoracic aortic disease, videoscopic thoracic procedures, minimally invasive cardiac procedures, the surgical treatment of atrial fibrillation, the introduction of robotics to contemporary cardiothoracic surgery, and more recently, ventricular assist devices and advanced trans-catheter valve therapies. He is currently Chairman, Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery' Director, Cardiovascular Service Line, Catholic Health Services Long Island, and Co-Director of the John Brancacchio Heart Valve Center, St. Francis Hospital.

In additions he has proven administrative skills as evidenced by continued success as president of a corporation of surgeons performing open heart surgery for over thirty years from one office in a single institution, as well as playing central roles in the governance of the hospital and staff organizations. He has served as president of the St. Francis Hospital Medical Staff. His group of surgeons currently composed of six out seven cardiac surgeons at St. Francis Hospital, and the surgeries they perform

comprise the bulk of the success that is reflected there, year in and year out. His group has achieved the most consistent, and the highest overall success rate in New York State.

His sentinel accomplishments on behalf of St. Francis Hospital and Catholic Health Services Long Island include (in chronological order):

- Established arterial revascularization as standard for coronary artery bypass graffing (1986)
- Appointed Managing Partner and system liaison for Cardiothoracic Surgery, PC, the oldest and single largest group of cardiac surgeons in the Metro area to date. (1995)
- Initiated and developed the largest and most successful minimally invasive cardiac surgery program on Long Island, and the longest continually running MICS practice in metro area (Currently among the top three Valvular Heart Surgeons in NY State). (1996)
- Performed the first Automatic Cardioverter Defibrillator at St. Francis Hospital. (1990)
- Introduced and developed one of the largest aortic surgery programs in the metro area.
- Established a program for the surgical treatment of atrial fibrillation. (Cox Maze II)
- Introduced Robotic Heart and Lung Surgery to St. Francis Hospital, and established a program with credentialing for the same.

Dr. Shah has served as the President of the Medical Staff, a member of the Franklin Hospital Board of Trustees & Community Advisory Board, and Chief of Urology. At present, he serves as the Chairman of the Medical Leadership Council.

Dr. Shashi Shah is very proud of the excellence in Urology care he has given throughout his time at Franklin Hospital. Dr. Shah still remembers his first challenging surgical case in private practice at Franklin Hospital, which took place on September 6, 1978, and many innovative procedures since then. Dr. Shashi Shah is also a Past President of the National Executive Committee of the Association of Indians in America and AIA-NY. He is serving as the Chairman of the A.I.A. Youth Development Fund. Dr. Shah was co-chairman of the International Convention of Rajasthan Association of North American (RANA) in 2006 and President of the organization in 2017.

Dr. Shah was one of the coordinators for the significant assistance by Northwell Health to India during the second Covid wave in India 2021.

Leaving India was not easy for the Shahs, as Shashi left behind his parents, four brothers, and sister. He is thankful to his family wife Pushpa, sons Rishi and Rahul, their partners Nazneen, Anjani, his grandchildren Mohan and Parul, and his friends for helping him where he is today. 1963 - 2020

Dr. Ajay K. Lodha A LEGEND May 4, 1963 - November 21, 2020 President, AAPIOLI 2014 and AAPI 2017

Dr. Ajay Lodha was a noble physician and stood as a role Model for his leadership, grit, and energy. He was a loving husband, a caring father, a supportive brother, and a very dear son. From his early roots in India, he held strong to his cultural values and dedicated time to his family as well as his personal, social, and professional endeavors. Ajay's energetic personality and pursuit for excellence guided his professional success, leadership acumen, and philanthropic work around the world.

Dr. Lodha graduated from R.N.T. Medical College, Udaipur and moved to New York where he owned nursing homes and developed his private practice: Queens Medical Services PLLC along with his wife Dr. Smita Lodha. As he grew professionally, he became an active and well-regarded member of the Indian diaspora in the United States.

Ajay served as the president of various renowned organizations, such as Rajasthan Association of North America (RANA), Rajasthan Medical Alumni Association (RAJMAAI), Association of Physicians of Indian Origin Queens-Long Island (AAPI-QLI), and National AAPI. He received many accolades for his contributions as he took these associations to new heights. In 2016, he earned the Ellis Island Medal of Honor for his transformative contributions to the greater Indian American community.

While Ajay achieved a decorated list of accomplishments, he was famous for providing relentless mentorship to his friends and family and guided many aspiring individuals to kickstart their healthcare careers. He used his entrepreneurial skills to assist many individuals to reach their own set of goals. Ajay was also a connoisseur of food and was well-known for his great hospitality, whether at home or at any organizational event which he was part of. He was a determined person and believed that anything was possible: "no" was never an answer as he was always ready to help others.

However, in March 2020, our hero contracted the coronavirus while treating the most vulnerable patients in the nursing homes. He was admitted to North Shore University Hospital in Manhasset, then transferred to Mt. Sinai Hospital in New York City where he stayed for two months, and finally transferred to Cleveland Clinic in Ohio for a double-lung transplant. He, along with his family, were determined that they were not going to let the virus win so easily. However, after a challenging eight-month battle with COVID-19 complications, Dr. Ajay Lodha peacefully passed away on the morning of November 21, 2020, surrounded by his loving family. Although our COVID Warrior is in God's abode, his journey on Earth is laden with remarkable achievements and inspirational stories for future generations.

Death leaves a heartache no one can heal; Love leaves a memory no one can steal. He was loved by hundreds of people and has created a space in everyone's heart. He is now one of God's Angels in heaven, but he was also a living Angel on Earth.

In his memory, a scholarship fund is established by his family with the help of AAPI-QLI to provide annual scholarships to deserving medical professionals on an ongoing basis who will use their knowledge, determination, and values to make this world a better place.
